The call came in on a nice early Spring day, 2019. “My name is Scott, and I have this most amazing cat”. No one could take her, so Scott found his way to us. He had been “working” with this stray cat (probably owned as she was spayed) for many months and she finally flipped the corner to allow rubs and pets. She was black and white, but hard to see the white as dust baths were her thing. Scott couldn’t take her into his already full cattery household so was reaching out. *Dom* came to live with us and engaged our hearts and minds. She was sweet and vocal, with a voracious appetite for food and love, but a bit disdainful of most of our forever felines in the Shelter. She wanted to be an only cat! One of our volunteers suggested we should test her for hyperthyroid (thanks Paula)! Her number was the highest our volunteer vet had seen. Meds were prescribed, which she took easily, and we

were told that she was a candidate for Radiocat therapy. Still a youngster, it was determined that she would respond well.

She continued to enthrall us with her antics, too numerous to mention. We had her with us for a long time, it seemed her forever person/people hadn’t yet met her. Therapy ensued, and her numbers didn’t come down as much as expected. We knew another round of therapy was in her future, then COVID hit. She had been advertised off and on for many months and then at last an inquiry was made. Meet and greet went well and she went to her new home. Bittersweet for us, but great for her! She has gone on to have her next therapy and as of press time was just declared to have a normally functioning thyroid. We were thrilled to get this news!

Caveat #1: Her rescuer, Scott, became a CASAS volunteer. He brought us 2 feral kittens this spring. We socialized them and they were adopted out together and are now doing great! We worked together to get their Mama spayed and she’s enjoying life with Scott’s mom.

Caveat #2: *Dom*’s adopter, who is a local Chef, held a fundraiser for CASAS at the restaurant where she creates amazing meals.
