What do we do when summer is over? Prepare for Spring!

This past summer we at CASAS have fostered several litters of very young kittens. They are now all adopted but this is the time to think of next kitten season.

Fostering babies ("neonatal kittens" which are birth to 4 weeks old), is time consuming but watching these little ones grow and develop is a great joy. These babies become well socialized to people. You may have thought about doing this. All you need to provide is time and patience. CASAS provides the nursing supplies, training and support.

Kitten babies require around the clock feeding and a warm place to rest as they cannot yet regulate their own body temperature. They also need stimulation to pee and poop. From birth to 2 weeks they will need feeding every 2-3 hours. From 3-4 weeks they can go through the night with a late evening feeding. At each feeding a kitten will need stimulation to pee and poop. Weaning and litter box training can start at 4 weeks old.

Until 7-10 days old, kitten's eyes are closed and ears are flat. Their sense of touch and smell are used to find mama. They cannot yet walk but squirm around with their limbs ("paddle") to move. By 2 weeks their eyes are open and their ears start to become erect. They start to lift themselves off the ground and by 3 weeks they walk with a shaky movement. By 4 weeks a kitten can walk well and start to climb. Watch out as they are fast moving!

To nurse from birth to 4 weeks, bottles or syringes with special nipples are used to feed a kitten. They are so small that at 1 week old, they only drink 5-7 cc. at a time. This is about a full teaspoon of milk! Gradually they will drink more at a time and go longer between feedings.

They do learn to bond with you and cuddle. It's great to see a kitten satisfied and fall asleep. Kittens become playful and need you to play as frequently as possible. Never leave children or other animals unsupervised with kittens.

You can be trained to care for young kittens with information and support. We have experienced kitten caregivers as well as manuals on kitten care and development available. Help is only a phone call away. If you are interested in becoming a foster provider for kittens, please call CASAS. Kitten season starts in March, so you will need to be trained during the winter. Training will be arranged.





# CROSSING OVER THE RAINBOW BRIDGE

As pet owners, the death of our furry friends is a sad fact of life. They are an integral part of our lives, and we grieve when they are gone. We are a no-kill shelter, but that does not mean we are immune to the passing of the kits in our care. Whether it's a cat that has been with us for some time who becomes ill. or new arrivals, older, that have health issues not previously diagnosed, or babies that contract life threatening conditions, that can't be fixed, despite our best efforts and extraordinary veterinary care. The catharsis for us at the Shelter is the scattering of the ashes of our departed kits in our garden during the Dia de los Muertos three day celebration, October 31-November 2. The ritual stems from an Aztec tradition of honoring the dead. We say a little something about each cat, as the wind takes the ashes, scattering them throughout the garden. We gave them the best we could in life.
